

Invasive Plant Removal in Martinez
Two Saturdays: Nov. 14 and Dec. 12 (9 am-noon)

These workdays are organized by members of the "Alhambra Watershed Council" and the "Friends of Alhambra Creek." Both are watershed groups that seek to protect and restore the creek and its surrounding watershed lands. We'll be working in cooperation with the City of Martinez public works staff.

We need about 12 - 18 volunteers to help cut down two patches of Giant Reed (*Arundo donax*) from the tributary of Alhambra Creek that runs along Alhambra Avenue.
