



RODEO CREEK WATERSHED VISION PLAN TOPICS

Interests and Concerns Categorized

Maintenance

1. Long-term and on-going maintenance adjacent to Rodeo Creek
2. Fence and trail/trash debris at Viewpoint and along creek side
3. Graffiti abatement
4. Agency accountability
5. Keep shopping carts/debris out of creek
6. Maintain concrete portion of creek and silt removal
7. Incorporate youth into clean-up
8. Organize monthly volunteer clean-ups

Public Access / Safety

1. Bank erosion between I-80 and Hawthorne
2. Public safety on trail
3. Dog owner control
4. Lack of law enforcement
5. Liability of homeowners associations for public at creek
6. Better (closer) access and visibility to creek
7. Find ways to combat negative influences/use along lower creek
8. Create and encourage community watch for creek corridor
9. Create opportunities for children to explore creek

Habitat / Creek

1. Siltation in channel
2. Restore native plants and habitats to lower creek
3. Remove dams/grade control structures
4. Use local plants to restore upper creek to stabilize and reduce erosion
5. More landscaping to soften concrete areas upstream of 3rd Street
6. Return frogs to creek
7. Improve fish migration and aquatic habitat and remove fish passage barriers
8. Separate areas for wildlife and exploration (people)

Watershed Information / Coordination

1. Future Pipe line construction
2. Identification of agencies roles and responsibilities
3. Encourage people to attend RMAC meetings
4. Gain knowledge of ALL planning efforts involved in watershed area
5. Bring more relevant information and resources to meetings
6. Create informational and interactive website about watershed area
7. Create watershed directory to share information

Connections and Waterfront

1. Extend path to Bay
2. Integrate marina into creek area
3. Regional trail connections
